Go4theGoal Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization founded in 2006 by Dr. Richard and Beth Stefanacci, soon after their oldest child was diagnosed with Ewing's Sarcoma, a rare form of bone cancer.

In 2011, Go4theGoal launched 2 national campaigns- National Pediatric Cancer Awareness Day and Lace Up 4 Pediatric Cancer®. These campaigns give schools, businesses, and sports teams an opportunity to raise awareness and much needed support for kids battling cancer.

Since Lace Up 4 Pediatric Cancer® began in 2011, there have been over 350,000 athletes in all sports and all levels wearing the gold laces in support.

Go4theGoal provides children undergoing cancer treatment and their families with financial assistance, funds hospital-based programs, grants special wishes, and has funded over \$1,000,000.00 in research since 2007. For the past 5 consecutive years, Go4theGoal has earned the honor of "Top Rated Non-Profit" by Great Nonprofits.
